




The Architecture of Bliss


Superhuman Bliss (#1): Mastery of our reward circuitry promises gradients of genetically engineered well-being, orders of magnitude richer than today's "peak experiences".

The Meaning of Life Resolved (#12): Genetically preprogrammed bliss ensures all sentient beings find life self-intimatingly valuable. Pathologies like existential angst are metabolically impossible.

Beautiful New Emotions (#13): Nasty human emotions are retired. Novel emotions are biologically synthesized and integrated. All emotion is beautiful.

Transhuman Psychedelia

(#5): Gene-editing tools open up modes of consciousness that make the weirdest human DMT trip akin to watching paint dry. "Bad trips" are physically physically impossible as the molecular signature of experience below 'hedonic zero' is missing.

Supersentience (#6):

Bigger brains with reprogrammed, netenabled neurons create an intensity of experience that makes Darwinian humans resemble sleepwalkers. We don't yet understand what 'posthuman intensity of experience' truly means.




Reversible Mind-Melding (#7):

Technologies like reversible thalamic bridges allow for a revolution in ethics and empathy, enabling direct experience-sharing between beings.

Super-spirituality (#20): Neuroscience identifies and amplifies the molecular signatures of spiritual experience, enabling lifelong spiritual ecstasies beyond the epiphanies of temporal-lobe epileptics.

Posthuman Aesthetics (#15): The molecular signatures of aesthetic experience are identified, purified, and overexpressed. Life is saturated with superhuman beauty.

21st Century Lifespan

Year 3000: Indefinite Youth

Eternal Youth (#2)

Indefinitely extended youth and effectively unlimited lifespans. "Aging" exists only in the medical archives. Automated off-world backups allow "respawning" after catastrophic accidents.

Physical Superhealth (#17)

Everyone feels physically and psychologically 'better than well". Darwinian pathologies like fatigue and malaise are inconceivable. Albased nociception with optional manual overrides replaces ancestral pain pathways.

The Reproductive Revolution

(#21): The genetic crapshoot of Darwinian sexual reproduction is replaced by precision-engineered sentience. Most transhumans originate as extra-uterine "designer babies".



Gender Transformation (#16):

"Gender" in the human sense is a thing of the past. Cognitive styles transcend crude dichotomies and can be shifted via embedded Al.

Morphological freedom is effectively unbounded.



The Anti-Speciesist Revolution

(#8): Arbitrary prejudice against sentient beings based on species is unthinkable. Sentience is valued over sapience. Factory farms and slaughterhouses are in the dustbin of history.




A New Civilizational Operating System


Full-Spectrum Superintelligences (#3): Ubiquitous Al underpins the illusion that reality conspires to help us. A flourishing ecology of nonbiological quantum computers and hyperintelligent digital zombies manages the world.

World Government (#18): Routine policy decisions are offloaded to ultra-intelligent zombie Al. Zero-sum primate status games are ancient history. Conflict resolution is superseded by diplomatic 'mind-melds'.

Unlimited Material Abundance (#14): Molecular nanotechnology has ended scarcity. Ugly evolutionary hangovers like status goods and the cash nexus have withered and died.



Mastering Virtual and Physical Worlds




Programmable Biospheres (#9): CRISPR and synthetic gene drives have reworked the global ecosystem into surreal gardens of eden. 'Nanny Al' provides benign supervision, ensuring no sentient being suffers.

Immersive VR (#4): Augmented reality is superseded by hyperreal virtual worlds with different laws and narrative structures. Most infrastructure maintenance in 'basement reality' is delegated to zombie Al.

Galactic Colonization (#23): Terraforming and 3D-bioprinting of post-Darwinian life on nearby solar systems is proceeding apace. Some ethicists favor creating a 'utilitronium shockwave' to convert unprogrammed matter into pure pleasure.


The Symbiotic System of a Recalibrated World

The Final Questions: Recalibrating Understanding

The Theory of Everything is Known (#10): The formalism of the TOE is known. Wavefunction monism and the superposition principle hold the key, though the full implications for subjective experience are still being explored.

(#11): The question of how physicalism can be reconciled with phenomenal experience has been answered. Mankind's best theory of the world is no longer inconsistent with one's own existence.
